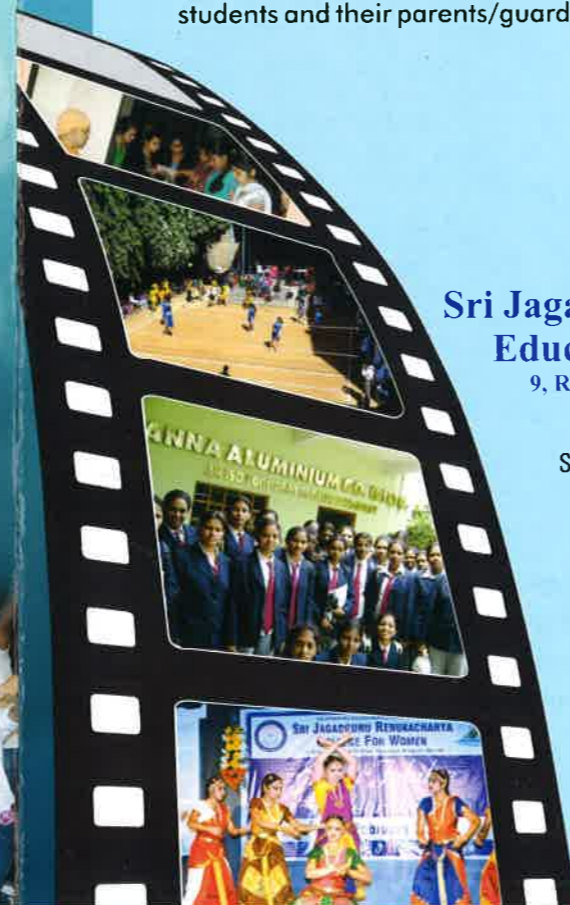
Admission information :

- ❑ Application form and prospectus can be availed from the college office for a prescribe fee / Application form can also be downloaded from the college website.
- ❑ Application should be submitted in the office on or before the prescribed date.
- ❑ Separate application must be submitted, if applying for more than one combination.
- ❑ The application should be submitted along with the attested photocopies of transfer certificate and the marks statement.
- ❑ Original documents must be produced at the time of admission.
- ❑ Students from other universities must produce their migration certificate.
- ❑ Students from other states should produce their Certificate of Eligibility from University along with filled in application form.
- ❑ Students seeking admission to any course, should affix **1 passport size photograph** to their application form and submit **3 passport size photographs** at the time of admission.
- ❑ The languages chosen must be the same as those chosen for their qualifying examination.
- ❑ All admissions are provisional and subject to approval of the Bangalore University.
- ❑ Students thus selected, should pay the prescribed fee on or before the notified date.
- ❑ Fee paid on admission will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- ❑ If the minimum strength of 15 is not fulfilled, the courses / combinations concerned will be cancelled and in such cases the whole fees, except the application and prospectus charges will be refunded.
- ❑ Every student must comply with the college code of conduct.



Student's Code of conduct

- ❑ Violation of code of conduct will be viewed seriously.
- ❑ Students lacking discipline, will not be admitted to the higher class even if they qualify for it.
- ❑ Students and parents/guardians at the time of admission, must carefully read the code of conduct and undertake to submit to its enforcement.
- ❑ Students should obtain leave of absence, in case they are unable to attend classes due to unavoidable circumstances.
- ❑ Students with less than 75% of attendance in both theory and practical classes will not be permitted to take-up their examination.
- ❑ College property should be handled with care. Failure of which, is susceptible to heavy penalty.
- ❑ Students must spend their free time usefully in the campus, reading room or the library. They must not leave the campus until the last bell for the day.
- ❑ All tests and examinations must necessarily be taken-up by the students.
- ❑ Students should carry their identity card and produce it on demand, by the college staff.
- ❑ Students must regularly see the notice board for important announcements. They will not be excused on the ground of ignorance about it.
- ❑ The decision of the principal shall be final and binding on all students and their parents/guardians.
